## Supply Lists

November 5, 2016

### Seward: Box Bag

#### MATERIALS:

- 1 Fat Quarter or 1/2 yd. fabric for exterior
- 1 Fat Quarter or 1/2 yd. fabric for lining
- 1/2 yd. fusible interfacing \*\*\*

(OR substitute 1/2 yard or fat quarter of pre-quilted material)

- 12" zipper
- Thread
- Rotary Cutter & Mat and or scissors
- Quilting ruler or templates measuring:
  - o 12 x 16"
  - o 8 x 10 "
  - o 1 x 1 ."
- Tailors chalk or water soluble fabric marker
- Optional:
  - 1/4" seam foot (optional)
  - Zipper foot (optional)

\*\*\* The type of interfacing used will determine how your finished bag appears. Lightweight interfacing will produce a soft bag that is easily collapsed while a heavy weight interfacing (or even TimTex / Peltex) will make a box bag that is firmer & holds it's boxy shape.

Cotton fabric (15" x 2 1/4" piece)

Fusible interfacing (15" x 2 1/4" piece)

Key Fob hardware, 1.25 inch -- **these will be available at the Guild meeting**

Sewing machine and standard sewing supplies needed.
