



Christmas Flower Block
8"
2 Fabrics

Cutting:

Background:

4 squares @ 2 1/2"

8 rectangles @ 2" x 2 1/2"

4 rectangles @ 1 1/2" x 4"

Christmas Print

12 squares @ 2"


1 square @ 1 1/2"

Piecing:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 8 of the Christmas Print 2" squares.

To make these units (similar to quick corner units):

With the background on the bottom, Christmas Print on the top, place the two fabrics right sides together, aligning the raw edges.




Sew on the drawn line. Make 4 in each direction. Fold the square up and check to make sure you have sewn accurately. Trim the excess corner fabric, leaving 1/4" seam allowances. Press toward the background.



Referring to the diagram at left, stitch together background 2 1/2" square, 2 pieced rectangles, and a 2" Christmas Print square. Make 4.

Following the block picture above, lay out your pieces in a nine patch. Sew into three rows, then sew the rows together.



The best part is no points to match when sewing your blocks into a quilt. To make it a scrappy quilt, you only need 3/4 of a 2" strip of your focus fabric for each block. Enjoy, Grace
