



Economy Patch Variation
12"
4 Fabrics

Cutting:

1 square each @ 7 1/4" cut twice diagonally from red, green and light cream fabrics
1 square @ 6 1/2" from tan/gold fabric

Piecing:

1. Corner units:


Sew a green and light cream triangle together on the short bias side, keeping the green on the left.
Press to the green. Make 4.



2. Center (Square in a Square) unit:

Center and sew the long side of 2 red triangles to opposite sides of the tan/gold square. Press to the red.

Center and sew the long side of the 2 remaining red triangles to the other two sides of the tan/gold square. Press to the red. Trim the dog ears.



3. Sew the corner units to the center unit in the same way as you constructed the center unit—first sew to two opposite sides, press away from the center unit, then sew the remaining corner units to the other two sides of the center unit.

This block makes an interesting secondary design when set together in a quilt.
