



Flying Cloud
12" Block
3 Fabrics

Cutting:

Background/Gray:

4 squares @ 3 1/2"
1 square @ 7 1/4" cut twice diagonally
2 squares @ 3" cut once diagonally

Pink:

4 squares @ 3 7/8" cut once diagonally
2 squares @ 3" cut once diagonally

Blue:

2 squares @ 3 7/8" cut once diagonally

Piecing:

Flying Geese Units:

Sew the PINK 3 7/8" half-square triangles to the short sides of the GRAY quarter-square triangles. Make 4.



Pinwheel Unit:

Sew the PINK and GRAY 3" half-square triangles together to make 4 HST units. Press to the PINK.



Sew these together to make a pinwheel. Trim to 4 3/4" raw if necessary.

Pinwheel in a Square—center unit:

Sew the 4 BLUE 3 7/8" half-square triangles to the sides of the pinwheel unit just made:



First sew to 2 opposite sides, press toward triangles.

Next, sew the remaining 2 triangles to the other opposite sides.

Press toward the triangles. This should measure 6 1/2" raw.

Center row:

Sew a flying geese unit to opposite sides of the center unit.



Top and Bottom rows:

Sew a 3 1/2" square to each end of a flying geese unit. Make 2.



Following the block diagram above, sew the rows together.
