



**H Quilt Block**  
**6" block**  
**2 Fabrics**

**Cutting:**

**Print:**

2 rectangles @ 2 1/2" x 6 1/2"

1 square @ 2 1/2"

**Light Background:**

2 squares @ 2 1/2"

**Piecing:**

**Center Row:**

Sew a Background 2 1/2" square to both sides of the 2 1/2" Print square  
Press to the print square.

Following the block diagram above, sew the rectangles to the sides of the center row.  
Press toward the print rectangles.

A quick and easy block to whip up for that last minute quilt.

This is a great way to use up all those leftover jelly roll pieces. You only need 15 1/2" of a print fabric and 5" of a light background fabric. Set 6 x 8 you have a 36 x 48 quilt.
