



**Night Vision Variation**  
**12" Block**  
**3 Fabrics**

**Cutting:**

**Teal:**

1 square @ 4 1/2"  
2 squares @ 4 7/8" cut once diagonally

**Cream:**

2 squares @ 4 7/8" cut once diagonally

**Black:**

1 square @ 9 1/4" cut twice diagonally

**Piecing:**

**Three Fabric: Flying Geese Units: Teal and Cream**

Place the **Teal** triangle right sides together on top of the **Black** square triangle, matching corners, and stitch. Press the unit open, then repeat with the **Cream** triangle on the right side. Press open.




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**Partial Seam Piecing:**

With right sides together, align the corners of the **Teal** 4 1/2" square along the long (**Black**) side of the flying geese unit just made. Sew from the center of the square to the outside edge. Press away from the square.

You now have a complete side to add the next flying geese unit. Continue to add flying geese units in this manner. Continue to press each unit away from the center square. Be sure to fold the partially sewn unit out of the way when sewing the last unit to the center square.

Finish stitching the partial seam to complete the block.
