



The Sickle
12" finished
3 fabrics

Cutting:

Background (light):
1 square @ 6 $\frac{7}{8}$ "
4 squares @ 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Blue:
1 square @ 6 $\frac{7}{8}$ "

Pink:
4 squares @ 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Piecing:

Step 1:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the background/light square
Layer the 6 $\frac{7}{8}$ " light background square and the blue square right sides together, with the light square on top.


Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away on each side of the drawn line. Cut apart on the line. Press to the dark/blue. You have 2 blue/background half-square triangle units.

Step 2:

Sew the pink and background 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares into 2 four-patch units.

Step 3:

Following the block diagram above, sew step 1 & 2 units into 2 rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Set 3 x 3 this makes a quick baby quilt.
