**Cutting:**

**Navy:**

2 rectangles @ 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

2 squares @ 2 1/2"

**Turquoise:**

4 squares @ 2 1/2"

**Cream:**

2 rectangles @ 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

2 squares @ 2 1/2"

**Piecing:**

**Two-patch units**

Sew a Turquoise 2 1/2" square to a Navy 2 1/2" square. Make 2.

Sew a Turquoise 2 1/2" square to a White 2 1/2" square. Make 2.

Press these units away from the Turquoise.



**Quarter Block Units:**


Sew a Navy 2 1/2" by 4 1/2" rectangle to a Navy/Turquoise Two Patch unit. Make 2. Press to the Navy rectangle.

Sew A Cream 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle to a Cream/Turquoise Two Patch Unit. Make 2. Press to the Cream rectangle.



Following the block diagram above, lay out the 4 quarter block units in 2 rows. Sew the 2 rows. Sew the rows together—note the position of the turquoise squares.

This is an easy block but looks more complicated when set in a quilt with sashing.
